

Rebuilding Lives: Aas Mohammad's Journey from Loss to Recovery with Miles2Smile Foundation



In response to the demolition drive in Nuh, Miles2Smile Foundation initiated a fundraiser to support 57-year-old Aas Mohammad and his brother Hasan. The brothers, who had lived in their pucca homes since 1996, lost their residence and tea shop during the aftermath of the violence. Aas Mohammad received only two days' notice before the demolition, leaving his family with no time to salvage belongings. Tragically, **the loss caused his son to have a panic attack. The foundation provided Rs 1.5 lakh for medical expenses and raised Rs 3 lakh for rebuilding their home. Within weeks, the family moved into their new house.**
