Arif Sufi, a resident of Khargone, lost his plastic product factory in the violence that erupted on April 10, 2022, during the Ram Navami celebrations. What began as a religious procession spiraled into clashes between communities, leaving many businesses and homes destroyed. Authorities initiated a demolition drive, claiming the structures were illegal, but affected families, mostly from the Muslim community, insisted their properties were legally owned. In the face of this destruction, Miles2Smile stepped in, raising funds to help Arif rebuild his business and restore his livelihood.
