Violence, Injustice, and Hope: Asghar Khan's Story of Sendhwa Violence 2022





"They demolished our home, left us on the streets. Is this justice?" cried Asghar Khan, a resident of Sendhwa, Madhya Pradesh. In April 2022, as Ramadan and Ram-Navami coincided, communal violence engulfed the town, leaving Muslim families homeless. Asghar's 16-year-old daughter, Saba, hurled stones in self-defense when a violent mob stormed their house. This act led to criminal charges against her and the demolition of their home. When Miles2Smile met Asghar, he was broken. We launched a fundraiser to help him rebuild. His eyes gleamed with hope upon receiving aid, but countless others remained trapped in despair.
