The relentless violence against Muslims in India continues to claim innocent lives. In June, 23-year-old Chand Miya Khan was lynched by a mob allegedly linked to cow vigilantes. He and two companions were chased for 54 km and brutally killed. Miles2Smile visited his hometown, Lakhnauti, Shamli, to support the grieving family.

Chand had married just seven months earlier; his wife, now pregnant, mourns in silence, asking, "Will I get justice?" To ease their suffering, we ensured emotional support and, with help from donors, arranged a shop's annual rent and stock—restoring a source of livelihood and hope for Chand's broken family.
