Asma Khatoon's shop in Fatikroy, Tripura, was the backbone of her family, supporting daily expenses and her children's education. On January 10, 2026, while she was visiting her injured relative Musabbir Ali at the hospital after he was attacked by a mob, violence spread across the area. When Asma returned home, she found her shop looted and burned, along with several Muslim-owned homes and businesses. Left without income or security, she struggled to feed her family and rebuild her life. Witnessing her pain and loss, Miles2Smile decided to organize a fundraiser to help. Instead of temporary relief, the organization rebuilt her source of livelihood, giving Asma Khatoon and her family a chance to live with stability again.
