Masjid Taqi Azam Shah in Mehrauli, Delhi, is believed to be nearly 700–800 years old and has long served as a space for prayer and religious learning. Over the centuries, it has remained deeply connected to the local community, many of whom come from economically weaker backgrounds and work as daily wage labourers. In recent years, the mosque's sanitation facilities had fallen into disrepair. The old washrooms were damaged and unhygienic

I, making them unsafe for regular use. Recognising the urgent need for clean and functional facilities, Miles2Smile supported the construction work. The organisation supported the building of three new toilets, ensuring safer and more dignified sanitation access for worshippers and nearby residents.
