



A Shop of Hope: **Rebuilding Guddu's**

Guddu Khan , Shamli, Uttar Pradesh

In June 2024, while summer brought warmth across India, tragedy struck in Chhattisgarh. Guddu Khan (35), Saddam Qureshi (23), and Chand Miya Khan (23) were brutally lynched, allegedly by cow vigilantes, on suspicion of cattle smuggling. Chased for 54 km, they were beaten to death.

Guddu's four young children, his wife, and his grieving mother were left shattered, without support or income. During our visit, his mother's words echoed deep pain. In response, Miles2Smile launched a fundraiser to aid the family. With the support received, we helped Guddu's brother-in-law reopen his garment shop in Jammu, restoring hope and livelihood.
