"We are left with nothing," said 28-year-old Gulshan to Miles2Smile, her voice heavy with pain. On June 15, just days before Eid, bulldozers flattened her home in Bhainswahi, Mandla—one of 14 Muslim houses demolished amid allegations of cow smuggling. The police found nothing in her home. Yet her house, her dignity,
