Haseena and her husband Rujdaar, 60, lived in the foothills of the Aravallis with their three daughters and young son, struggling to make ends meet by rearing goats. Rujdaar had spent his life tending to livestock, while Haseena quietly supported her family. However, their world collapsed when their home was demolished, leaving them without land or property. The Haryana government's 2021 legislation allowed for the confiscation of private property during public disturbances, which further destabilized their already precarious situation. With no savings or land, they turned to **Foundation** the Miles2Smile for help. The foundation provided them with a temporary shelter made of bamboo and asbestos sheets, giving Haseena a sense of stability. Despite this, Rujdaar remains concerned for his daughters' future.
