Reviving Business, Restoring Happiness of Mohseen, Survivor of Khargone Violence 2022

Mohseen Khan, a survivor of the 2022 Khargone violence during Ram Navami, lost his only source of income when his mobile shop was allegedly burnt by a Hindutva mob. The violence, sparked by clashes between two processions at Talab Chowk, led to widespread unrest and a controversial demolition drive targeting mostly Muslim-owned properties. Devastated by a loss of ₹1-2 lakhs, Mohseen found hope through Miles2Smile, an NGO aiding survivors. We raised donations to rebuild and restock his shop, enabling him to regain his livelihood. Grateful, Mohseen celebrated Eid happily, saying, “Miles2Smile made this possible, even during the curfew.”
