

Story of Rahima



Rahima, a resident of Jahangirpuri's C block, lost her livelihood when her shop was demolished on April 20 as part of the demolition drive following the April 16 violence. Despite having a valid license, her store was destroyed, and the police reassured her that bulldozers were only clearing waste. Rahima, who used to earn Rs 300-500 daily selling water and snacks, now struggles to support her three children. Her family, once part of a peaceful community, is left devastated. Rahima, a school dropout, now relies on an NGO, Miles2Smile, to support her children's education.
